Year 5 Trip to Trinity

This week, 12 members of the Year 5 went to Trinity School for a Chemistry session. The children learnt about how to be safe in the Science Lab and how to operate a Bunsen burner before carrying out several experiments observing different chemical reactions, including water and calcium; alkaline and acid and calcium carbonate and hydrochloric acid. This short visit has given the children an even greater enthusiasm for Science I'm sure we have several future scientists in the making!
